* **Maintenance Committee** – Tom met with Foothills to review the new playground plans. Foothills had met earlier in May with a number of Canterbury kids and Foothills interviewed them concerning their ideas for the “ideal” playground. The kids submitted drawings which Foothills took back to their own architects. From the interviews and the drawings two different ideas were shown for the playground. Those who attended the second meeting voted on the new playground. The drawings can be found on the website. Construction is slated for August 11.

Foothills will provide more trees for Chaucer Park. The board is to submit their request for additional trees and Foothills will have them planted the same day that the new playground is installed. The installation of the playground is being done by local church volunteers.

* **Architectural Committee/Covenant Control:** - John Anthon presented a summary of matters. Both issues were concerning trailers and parking.
